



Charitable and Community Contributions

2009, Glenwood Springs, CO... Glenwood Springs is the home of many historical landmarks that contribute to the ongoing legacy and popularity of this mountain town. True to its heritage of western hospitality and generosity, the Glenwood Hot Springs has shown honorable community involvement with significant monetary donations.

In April 2007, the Glenwood Springs Chamber Resort Association named the Glenwood Hot Springs *Large Philanthropic Business of the Year*. Notable contributions included \$100,000 to help fund the new Heart and Vascular Center as part of a long-term partnership with Valley View Hospital; \$20,000 toward the construction of the Glenwood Springs Whitewater Park; and nearly \$50,000 donated annually to help sustain local organizations, charities, and youth activities. Operation Vacation, which provides free Glenwood Springs getaways to deserving soldiers and their families, has given away more than two dozen Glenwood Hot Springs packages. The Glenwood Hot Springs also provides hundreds of in-kind pool passes and dozens of lodging certificates to many organizations to use for fundraisers.

The Glenwood Hot Springs, a strong supporter of youth and education, makes contributions to numerous youth-oriented groups. Deserving high-school students are annually awarded \$10,000 in college scholarship funds, distributed over the course of four years. Community-sponsored events, such as Summer of Jazz, are part of the Glenwood Hot Springs' effort to support the local arts. Historic preservation projects are also key recipients of funds given out by the Glenwood Hot Springs. Medical research, service clubs, and memorials also benefit from these sources.

Employees of the Glenwood Hot Springs are very enthusiastic when it comes to contributing to good causes, whether it's for local use or for catastrophic disasters somewhere else in the country. During the holidays, employees donate toys to the United States Marines' Toys for Tots organization.
